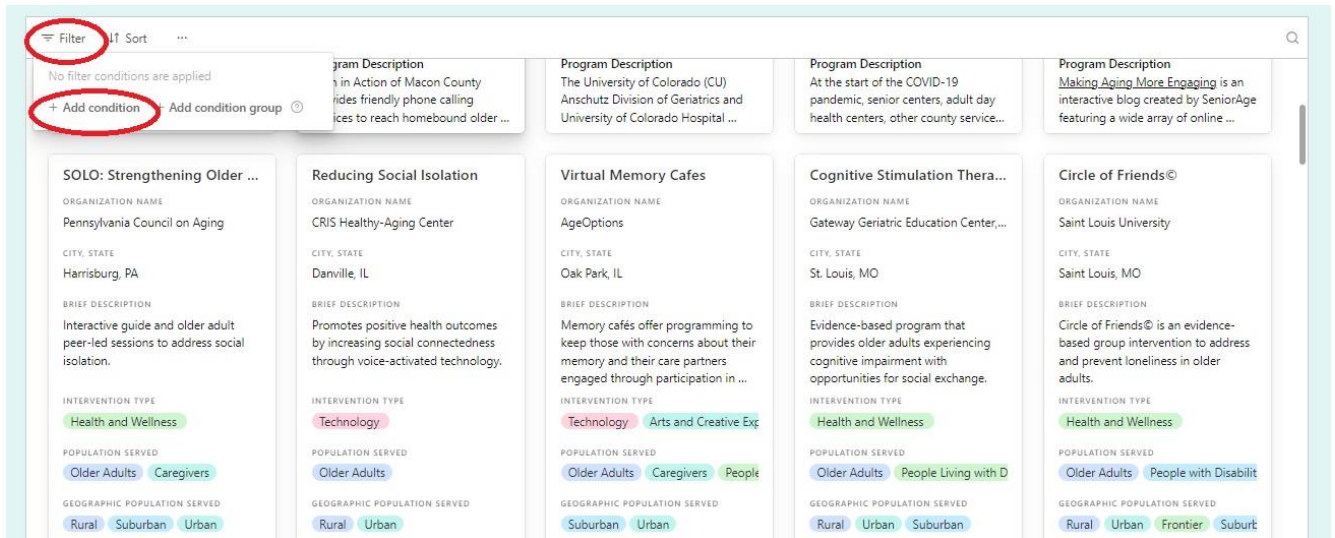


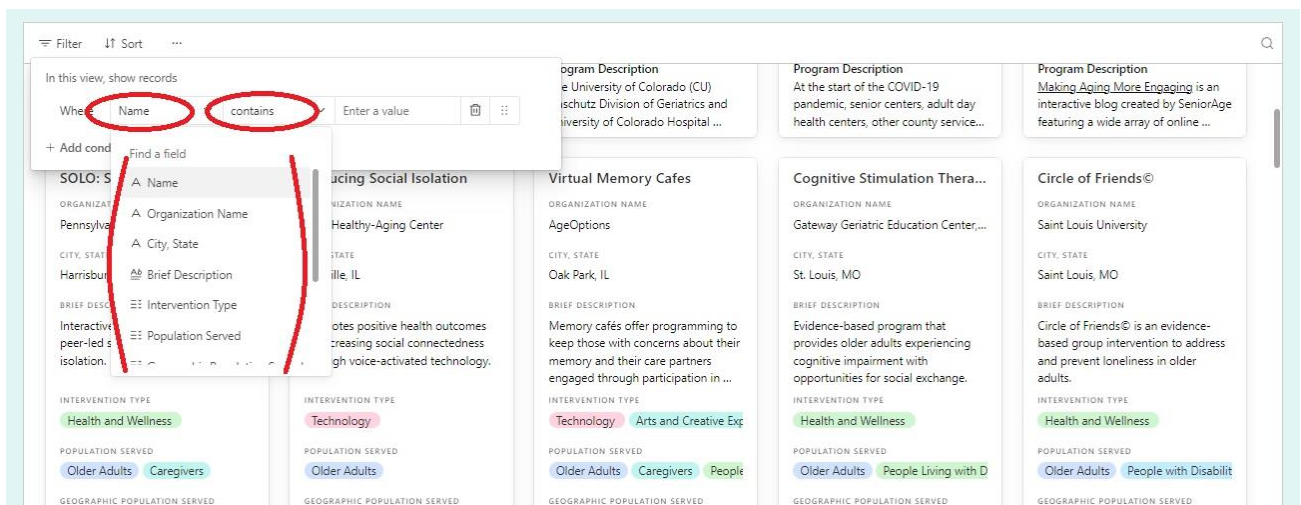
Search by Filter

To search the program summaries via the filter function:

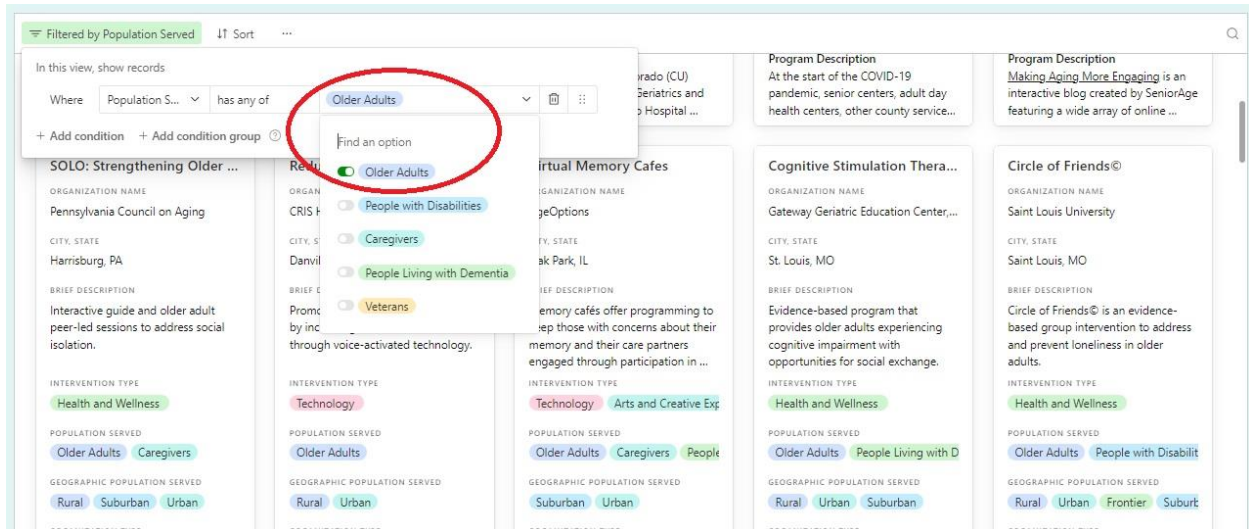
Step 1: Click the “Filter” button in the top left-hand corner. Click the “+ Add Condition” button.



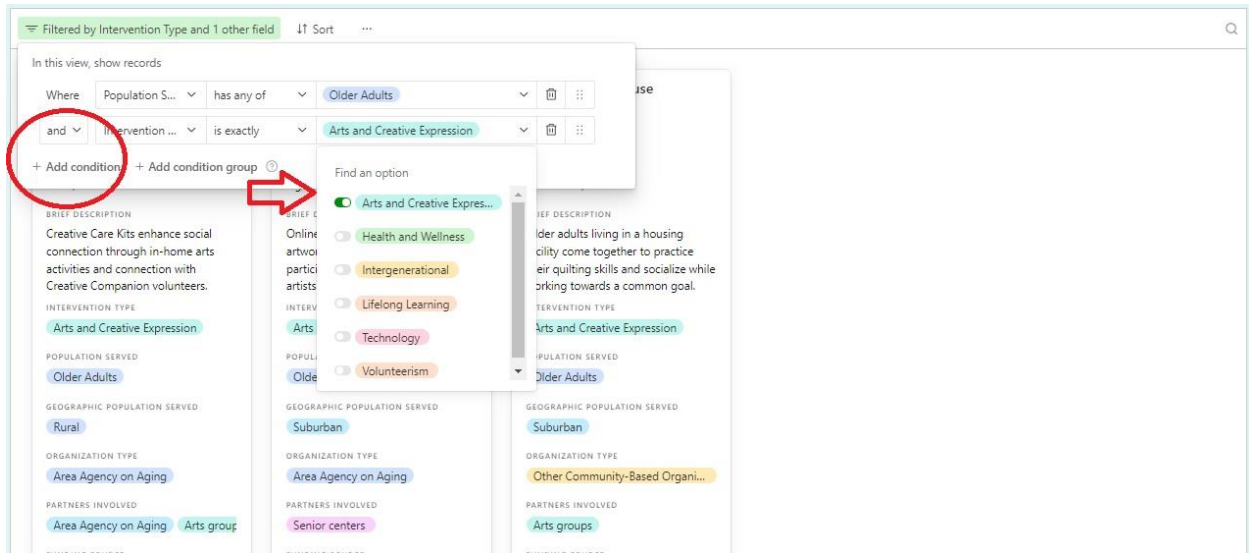
Step 2: Next, click on “Name,” which will drop down all of the fields that can be used to filter the Hub based on what you are searching for, like intervention type. You can use the second drop down to specify which factors must be, could be or should not be included in your search.



Step 3: After selecting a filter type in the drop down, you can select as many options as you wish to filter by in the gray box. For example, with the population served filter, you can just select one option like older adults or select multiple options, including people with disabilities or caregivers.



Step 4: If you wish to keep narrowing your search, you can continue adding various filters with the + Add Condition button, and your search results will be customized to the filters you create. As you use the filter function, only program summaries that meet your filter criteria will appear in the Hub.
